A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on fabrics of man-made fibers consisting of one or two layers of expanded polytetrafluoroethylene sheeting layered between an outer knit fabric wholly of nylon and another outer woven fabric containing by weight 65 percent or more of micro fiber polyester.

1 **SECTION 1. FABRICS OF MAN-MADE FIBERS CONSISTING**
2 **OF ONE OR TWO LAYERS OF EXPANDED**
3 **POLYTETRAFLUOROETHYLENE SHEETING**
4 **LAYERED BETWEEN AN OUTER KNIT FABRIC**
5 **WHOLLY OF NYLON AND ANOTHER OUTER**
6 **WOVEN FABRIC CONTAINING BY WEIGHT 65**
7 **PERCENT OR MORE OF MICRO FIBER POLY-**
8 **ESTER.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
10 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
11 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
12 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Fabrics of man-made fibers consisting of one or two layers of expanded polytetrafluoroethylene sheeting layered between an outer knit fabric wholly of nylon and another outer woven fabric containing by weight 65 percent or more of micro fiber polyester (provided for in subheading 5903.90.25)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.
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13 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
14 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
15 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
16 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
