A BILL

To extend and modify the temporary suspension of duty on certain women's footwear, not covering the ankle, designed to be worn in lieu of, but not over, other footwear as a protection against water, oil, grease, or chemicals or cold or inclement weather.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN WOMEN’S FOOTWEAR, NOT COVERING**
2 **THE ANKLE, DESIGNED TO BE WORN IN LIEU**
3 **OF, BUT NOT OVER, OTHER FOOTWEAR AS A**
4 **PROTECTION AGAINST WATER, OIL, GREASE,**
5 **OR CHEMICALS OR COLD OR INCLEMENT**
6 **WEATHER.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.23.83 of the Har-
8 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
9 certain women’s footwear, not covering the ankle, designed
10 to be worn in lieu of, but not over, other footwear as a
11 protection against water, oil, grease, or chemicals or cold
12 or inclement weather) is amended—

13 (1) in the article description, by striking “\$20/
14 pair” and inserting “\$23/pair”; and

15 (2) by striking the date in the effective period
16 column and inserting “12/31/2015”.

17 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
18 subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from
19 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
20 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
