A BILL

To extend and modify the temporary reduction of duty on certain men's footwear designed to be worn in lieu of, but not over, other footwear as a protection against water, oil, grease or chemicals or cold or inclement weather.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN MEN’S FOOTWEAR DESIGNED TO BE**
 2 **WORN IN LIEU OF, BUT NOT OVER, OTHER**
 3 **FOOTWEAR AS A PROTECTION AGAINST**
 4 **WATER, OIL, GREASE, OR CHEMICALS OR**
 5 **COLD OR INCLEMENT WEATHER.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.23.77 of the Har-
 7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
 8 certain men’s footwear designed to be worn in lieu of, but
 9 not over, other footwear as a protection against water, oil,
 10 grease or chemicals or cold or inclement weather) is
 11 amended—

12 (1) in the article description, by striking “\$20/
 13 pair” and inserting “\$23/pair”; and

14 (2) by striking the date in the effective period
 15 column and inserting “12/31/2015”.

16 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
 17 subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 18 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
 19 the date of the enactment of this Act.
