A BILL

To repeal a prohibition on the use of certain funds for the termination of the Constellation program of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. REPEAL OF THE PROHIBITION ON USE OF CERTAIN FUNDS FOR TERMINATION OF THE CONSTELLATION PROGRAM OF THE NATIONAL
AERONAUTICS AND SPACE ADMINISTRATION.

The Science Appropriations Act, 2010 (title III of division B of Public Law 111–117) is amended under the

- 3 SEC. 2. TERMINATION AUTHORITY FOR CERTAIN CON-
- 4 TRACTS.
- 5 The Administrator of the National Aeronautics and
- 6 Space Administration may terminate any contract under
- 7 the Constellation program that cannot be modified to com-
- 8 ply with the requirements of sections 302, 303, and 304
- 9 of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration Au-
- 10 thorization Act of 2010 if the Administrator publishes the
- 11 finding in the Federal Register not less than 30 days be-
- 12 fore the effective date of the termination and transmits
- 13 a copy of the finding to the Senate Committee on Com-
- 14 merce, Science, and Transportation, the House of Rep-
- 15 resentatives Committee on Science, Space, and Tech-
- 16 nology, and the House and Senate Committees on Appro-
- 17 priations.
