A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on knit garments of stretch fabric with textile or polymer-based electrodes knit into or attached to the fabric and that incorporate connectors designed to secure an electronic transmitter that transmits physiological information from the electrodes to a compatible monitor.

1 **SECTION 1. KNIT GARMENTS OF STRETCH FABRIC WITH**
2 **TEXTILE OR POLYMER-BASED ELECTRODES**
3 **KNIT INTO OR ATTACHED TO THE FABRIC**
4 **AND THAT INCORPORATE CONNECTORS DE-**
5 **SIGNED TO SECURE AN ELECTRONIC TRANS-**
6 **MITTER THAT TRANSMITS PHYSIOLOGICAL**
7 **INFORMATION FROM THE ELECTRODES TO A**
8 **COMPATIBLE MONITOR.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
10 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
11 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
12 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Knit garments of stretch fabric with textile or polymer-based electrodes knit into or attached to the fabric and that incorporate connectors designed to secure an electronic transmitter that transmits physiological information from the electrodes to a compatible monitor (provided for in subheading 6110.30.30)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.
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13 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
14 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
15 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
16 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
