A BILL

To reduce temporarily the duty on certain sports footwear valued over \$6.50 but not over \$12/pair.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN SPORTS FOOTWEAR VALUED OVER**

4 **\$6.50 BUT NOT OVER \$12/PAIR.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Sports footwear with outer soles and uppers of rubber or plastics, valued over \$6.50 but not over \$12/pair, the foregoing not for men (provided for in subheading 6402.19.70)	47¢/pr. + 10.5%	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.
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1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
