A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on staple fibers of viscose rayon, not carded, combed, or otherwise processed for spinning, measuring 1.67 to 16.67 decitex and having a fiber length each measuring 20 mm or more but not over 150 mm.

1 **SECTION 1. STAPLE FIBERS OF VISCOSE RAYON, NOT**
2 **CARDED, COMBED, OR OTHERWISE PROC-**
3 **ESSED FOR SPINNING, MEASURING 1.67 TO**
4 **16.67 DECITEX AND HAVING A FIBER LENGTH**
5 **EACH MEASURING 20 MM OR MORE BUT NOT**
6 **OVER 150 MM.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.23.33 of the Har-
8 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
9 staple fibers of viscose rayon, not carded, combed, or oth-
10 erwise processed for spinning, measuring 1.67 to 16.67
11 decitex and having a fiber length each measuring 20 mm
12 or more but not over 150 mm) is amended by striking
13 the date in the effective period column and inserting “12/
14 31/2015”.

15 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
16 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
17 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
18 the date of the enactment of this Act.
