To extend the temporary suspension of duty on acrylic staple fiber, dyed, not carded, combed, or otherwise processed for spinning, with a cut fiber length of 89 mm to 140 mm and a target length of 115 mm.

1 **SECTION 1. ACRYLIC STAPLE FIBER, DYED, NOT CARDED,**
2 **COMBED, OR OTHERWISE PROCESSED FOR**
3 **SPINNING, WITH A CUT FIBER LENGTH OF 89**
4 **MM TO 140 MM AND A TARGET LENGTH OF 115**
5 **MM.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.40.30 of the Har-
7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
8 acrylic staple fiber, dyed, not carded, combed, or otherwise
9 processed for spinning, with a cut fiber length of 89 mm
10 to 140 mm and a target length of 115 mm) is amended
11 by striking the date in the effective period column and
12 inserting “12/31/2015”.

13 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
14 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
15 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
16 the date of the enactment of this Act.
