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## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on acrylic staple fibers, dyed but not carded, combed, or otherwise processed for spinning, with a cut fiber length of 100 mm to 135 mm and a target length of 120 mm.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. ACRYLIC STAPLE FIBERS, DYED BUT NOT**  
2 **CARDED, COMBED, OR OTHERWISE PROC-**  
3 **ESSED FOR SPINNING, WITH A CUT FIBER**  
4 **LENGTH OF 100 MM TO 135 MM AND A TARGET**  
5 **LENGTH OF 120 MM.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.40.23 of the Har-  
7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
8 acrylic staple fibers, dyed but not carded, combed, or oth-  
9 erwise processed for spinning, with a cut fiber length of  
10 100 mm to 135 mm and a target length of 120 mm) is  
11 amended by striking the date in the effective period col-  
12 umn and inserting “12/31/2015”.

13 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
14 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
15 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
16 the date of the enactment of this Act.
