Mrs. HAGAN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on acrylic fiber tow containing 85 percent or more by weight of acrylonitrile units and 2 percent or more but not over 3 percent of water, raw white (undyed), crimped, with an average decitex of 3.3 (plus or minus 10 percent) and an aggregate filament measure in the tow bundle between 660,000 and 1,200,000 decitex, with a length greater than 2 meters.

1 **SECTION 1. ACRYLIC FIBER TOW CONTAINING 85 PERCENT**
 2 **OR MORE BY WEIGHT OF ACRYLONITRILE**
 3 **UNITS AND 2 PERCENT OR MORE BUT NOT**
 4 **OVER 3 PERCENT OF WATER, RAW WHITE**
 5 **(UNDYED), CRIMPED, WITH AN AVERAGE**
 6 **DECITEX OF 3.3 (PLUS OR MINUS 10 PER-**
 7 **CENT) AND AN AGGREGATE FILAMENT MEAS-**
 8 **URE IN THE TOW BUNDLE BETWEEN 660,000**
 9 **AND 1,200,000 DECITEX, WITH A LENGTH**
 10 **GREATER THAN 2 METERS.**

11 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.40.14 of the Har-
 12 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
 13 acrylic fiber tow containing 85 percent or more by weight
 14 of acrylonitrile units and 2 percent or more but not over
 15 3 percent of water, raw white (undyed), crimped, with an
 16 average decitex of 3.3 (plus or minus 10 percent) and an
 17 aggregate filament measure in the tow bundle between
 18 660,000 and 1,200,000 decitex, with a length greater than
 19 2 meters) is amended by striking the date in the effective
 20 period column and inserting “12/31/2015”.

21 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 22 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 23 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
 24 the date of the enactment of this Act.
