A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain plaiting material products suitable for use in window shades.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN PLAITING MATERIAL PRODUCTS**

4 **SUITABLE FOR USE IN WINDOW SHADES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Plaiting material products suitable for use in window shades, in rolls each having an area measuring over 27.85 m ² but less than 46.46 m ² , of wood slats each measuring over 6 mm or more but not greater than 8 mm in width or over 22 mm or more but not to exceed 25 mm in width and measuring 1 mm or more but not greater than 2 mm in thickness, and/or bamboo reeds measuring 1 mm or more but not greater than 2.5 mm in width, and/or marupa wood rods measuring over 1.5 mm or more but not greater than 3 mm in diameter, and/or paper rope, the foregoing woven with polyester yarn into a repeating pattern which may also include jute, polyester yarn or paper (provided for in sub-heading 4601.94.20)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.
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1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
