A BILL

To extend and modify the temporary reduction of duty on acrylic filament tow imported in the form of 8 sub-bundles crimped together, each containing 24,000 filaments (plus or minus 10 percent).

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ACRYLIC FILAMENT TOW IMPORTED IN THE**
4 **FORM OF 8 SUB-BUNDLES CRIMPED TO-**
5 **GETHER, EACH CONTAINING 24,000 FILA-**
6 **MENTS (PLUS OR MINUS 10 PERCENT).**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.40.21 of the Har-
8 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to

1 acrylic filament tow imported in the form of 8 sub-bundles
2 crimped together, each containing 24,000 filaments (plus
3 or minus 10 percent)) is amended—

4 (1) by striking “1.2%” in the column 1 general
5 rate of duty column and inserting “Free”; and

6 (2) by striking the date in the effective period
7 column and inserting “12/31/2015”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
10 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
11 the date of the enactment of this Act.
