To extend the temporary suspension of duty on acrylic filament tow imported in the form of bundles of crimped product each containing 214,000 filaments (plus or minus 10 percent).

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ACRYLIC FILAMENT TOW IMPORTED IN THE**
4 **FORM OF BUNDLES OF CRIMPED PRODUCT**
5 **EACH CONTAINING 214,000 FILAMENTS (PLUS**
6 **OR MINUS 10 PERCENT).**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.40.22 of the Har-
8 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to

1 acrylic filament tow imported in the form of bundles of
2 crimped product each containing 214,000 filaments (plus
3 or minus 10 percent)) is amended by striking the date in
4 the effective period column and inserting “12/31/2015”.

5 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
6 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
7 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
8 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
