A BILL

To require the Attorney General to issue a report on the Alaska Rural Justice and Law Enforcement Commission.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPORT ON ALASKA RURAL JUSTICE AND LAW**
4 **ENFORCEMENT COMMISSION.**

5 Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment
6 of this Act, the Attorney General, in consultation with the
7 Attorney General of the State of Alaska, the Commis-
8 sioner of Public Safety of the State of Alaska, the Alaska
9 Federation of Natives, and federally recognized Indian
10 tribes in the State of Alaska, shall submit to Congress a

1 report on whether the Alaska Rural Justice and Law En-
2 forcement Commission established under section
3 112(a)(2) of division B of the Consolidated Appropriations
4 Act, 2004 (Public Law 108–199; 118 Stat. 62) should be
5 continued and appropriations authorized for the continued
6 work of the Commission. The report may contain rec-
7 ommendations for legislation with respect to the scope of
8 work and composition of the Commission.

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
