## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Autonomy for Psy-5 chologists and Social Workers Act of 2011".

1SEC. 2. REMOVAL OF RESTRICTION THAT A CLINICAL PSY-2CHOLOGIST OR CLINICAL SOCIAL WORKER3PROVIDE SERVICES IN A COMPREHENSIVE4OUTPATIENT REHABILITATION FACILITY TO5A PATIENT ONLY UNDER THE CARE OF A6PHYSICIAN.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1861(cc)(2)(E) of the So-8 cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x(cc)(2)(E)) is amended by striking "physician" and inserting "physician, except 9 that a patient receiving qualified psychologist services (as 10 defined in subsection (ii)) may be under the care of a clin-11 ical psychologist with respect to such services to the extent 12 13 permitted under State law and except that a patient re-14 ceiving clinical social worker services (as defined in subsection (hh)(2) may be under the care of a clinical social 15 worker with respect to such services to the extent per-16 mitted under State law". 17

18 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by19 subsection (a) shall apply to services provided on or after20 January 1, 2012.

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
