## A BILL

To include nonprofit and volunteer ground and air ambulance crew members and first responders for certain benefits.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Dale Long Emergency
- 5 Medical Service Providers Protection Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY.
- 7 Section 1204 of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control
- 8 and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3796b) is amend-
- 9 ed—

1	(1) in paragraph (7), by striking "public em-
2	ployee member of a rescue squad or ambulance
3	crew;" and inserting "employee or volunteer member
4	of a rescue squad or ambulance crew (including a
5	ground or air ambulance service) that—
6	"(A) is a public agency; or
7	"(B) is (or is a part of) a nonprofit entity
8	serving the public that—
9	"(i) is officially authorized or licensed
10	to engage in rescue activity or to provide
11	emergency medical services; and
12	"(ii) is officially designated as a pre-
13	hospital emergency medical response agen-
14	cy;"; and
15	(2) in paragraph (9)—
16	(A) in subparagraph (A), by striking "as a
17	chaplain" and all that follows through the semi-
18	colon, and inserting "or as a chaplain;";
19	(B) in subparagraph (B)(ii), by striking
20	"or" after the semicolon;
21	(C) in subparagraph (C)(ii), by striking
22	the period and inserting "; or"; and
23	(D) by adding at the end the following:
24	"(D) a member of a rescue squad or am-
25	bulance crew who, as authorized or licensed by

- law and by the applicable agency or entity (and as designated by such agency or entity), is engaging in rescue activity or in the provision of emergency medical services.".
- 5 SEC. 3. OFFSET.
- 6 Of the unobligated balances available under the De-
- 7 partment of Justice Assets Forfeiture Fund, \$12,000,000
- 8 are permanently cancelled.
- 9 SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- The amendments made by section 2 shall apply only
- 11 to injuries sustained on or after June 1, 2009.
