A BILL

To provide the FCC with authority to conduct incentive auctions, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Spectrum Optimization

5 Act".

6 SEC. 2. PROVISION OF INCENTIVE AUCTION AUTHORITY.

7 Paragraph (8) of section 309(j) of the Communica-

8 tions Act of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 309(j)) is amended—

1	(1) in subparagraph (A), by striking "(B), (D),
2	and (E) ," and inserting "(B), (D) , (E) , and (F) ,";
3	and
4	(2) by adding at the end the following:
5	"(F) VOLUNTARY INCENTIVE AUCTION AU-
6	THORITY.—
7	"(i) Establishment of rules.—
8	Not later than 180 days after the date of
9	enactment of the Spectrum Optimization
10	Act, the Commission shall establish rules
11	for the conduct of auctions of licensed
12	spectrum that is voluntarily relinquished
13	by a licensee for assignment of new initial
14	licenses subject to new service rules or for
15	other purposes, in which a portion of the
16	auction proceeds are shared with such re-
17	linquishing licensees, consistent with the
18	public interest in maximizing utilization of
19	the spectrum.
20	"(ii) Content of Rules.—The rules
21	established under clause (i) shall—
22	"(I) identify the initial spectrum
23	band or bands that will be eligible for
24	incentive auctions under this subpara-
25	graph;

1	"(II) establish a maximum rev-
2	enue sharing threshold applicable to
3	all licensees within any auction, unless
4	the establishment of such threshold
5	would increase the amount of spec-
6	trum cleared or would increase the net
7	revenue from the auction of such
8	spectrum; and
9	"(III) minimize the cost to the
10	taxpayer of the transition of the spec-
11	trum to be auctioned to its newly
12	identified use.
13	"(iii) Schedule for auctions.—
14	"(I) INITIAL AUCTION.—The
15	Commission shall commence incentive
16	auctions under this subparagraph not
17	later than 2 years after the date of
18	enactment of the Spectrum Optimiza-
19	tion Act.
20	"(II) OTHER SPECTRUM.—The
21	Commission may, in its discretion and
22	at any time after the date of enact-
23	ment of the Spectrum Optimization
24	Act, use the authority provided in this
25	subparagraph in connection with the

1auction of other licensed spectrum,2provided that the auction of such3other spectrum is conducted pursuant4to the rules established under this5subparagraph.".
