## A BILL

For the relief of Esidronio Arreola-Saucedo, Maria Elna Cobian Arreola, Nayely Arreola Carlos, and Cindy Jael Arreola.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.
- 4 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 5 sion of law or any order, for the purposes of the Immigra-
- 6 tion and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.),
- 7 Esidronio Arreola-Saucedo, Maria Elna Cobian Arreola,
- 8 Nayely Arreola Carlos, and Cindy Jael Arreola shall be
- 9 deemed to have been lawfully admitted to, and remained
- 10 in, the United States, and shall be eligible for issuance

- 1 of an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status under
- 2 section 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8)
- 3 U.S.C. 1255).
- 4 (b) Application and Payment of Fees.—Sub-
- 5 section (a) shall apply only if the applications for issuance
- 6 of immigrant visas or the applications for adjustment of
- 7 status are filed with appropriate fees not later than 2
- 8 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.
- 9 (c) Reduction of Immigrant Visa Numbers.—
- 10 Upon the granting of immigrant visas to Esidronio
- 11 Arreola-Saucedo, Maria Elna Cobian Arreola, Nayely
- 12 Arreola Carlos, and Cindy Jael Arreola, the Secretary of
- 13 State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 4, dur-
- 14 ing the current or subsequent fiscal year, the total number
- 15 of immigrant visas that are made available to natives of
- 16 the country of birth of Esidronio Arreola-Saucedo, Marina
- 17 Elna Cobian Arreola, Nayely Arreola Carlos, and Cindy
- 18 Jael Arreola under section 203(a) of the Immigration and
- 19 Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)) or, if applicable, the
- 20 total number of immigrant visas that are made available
- 21 to natives of the country of birth of Esidronio Arreola-
- 22 Saucedo, Maria Elna Cobian Arreola, Nayely Arreola Car-
- 23 los, and Cindy Jael Arreola under section 202(e) of such
- 24 Act (8 U.S.C. 1152(c)).

- 1 (d) PAYGO.—The budgetary effects of this Act, for
- 2 the purpose of complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-
- 3 Go Act of 2010, shall be determined by reference to the
- 4 latest statement titled "Budgetary Effects of PAYGO
- 5 Legislation" for this Act, submitted for printing in the
- 6 Congressional Record by the Chairman of the Senate
- 7 Budget Committee, provided that such statement has been
- 8 submitted prior to the vote on passage.
