## A BILL

For the relief of Jacqueline W. Coats.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 2 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR JAC-4 QUELINE W. COATS. 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a) 6 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality 7 Act (8 U.S.C. 1151), Jacqueline W. Coats shall be eligible 8 for issuance of an immigrant visa or for adjustment of 9 status to that of an alien lawfully admitted for permanent 10 residence upon filing an application for issuance of an im-11 migrant visa under section 204 of that Act (8 U.S.C.

1 1154) or for adjustment of status to lawful permanent
 2 resident.

3 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Jacqueline W. 4 Coats enters the United States before the filing deadline 5 specified in subsection (c), Jacqueline W. Coats shall be 6 considered to have entered and remained lawfully in the 7 United States and shall be eligible for adjustment of sta-8 tus under section 245 of the Immigration and Nationality 9 Act (8 U.S.C. 1255) as of the date of enactment of this 10 Act.

(c) APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the application for
issuance of an immigrant visa or the application for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees not later
than 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.
(d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBERS.—
Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent residence to Laccueling W. Costa, the Secretary of State shall

Coats under section 202(e) of that

3 (e) PAYGO.—The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-4 5 Go Act of 2010, shall be determined by reference to the latest statement titled "Budgetary Effects of PAYGO 6 Legislation" for this Act, submitted for printing in the 7 Congressional Record by the Chairman of the Senate 8 9 Budget Committee, provided that such statement has been submitted prior to the vote on passage. 10
