### **3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Nursing School Clinics
- 5 Act of 2011".

## 6 SEC. 2. MEDICAID COVERAGE OF SERVICES PROVIDED BY 7 NURSING SCHOOL CLINICS.

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1905(a) of the Social Se9 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1396d(a)) is amended—

(1) in paragraph (28), by striking "and" at the
end;
(2) by redesignating paragraph $(29)$ as para-
graph $(30)$ ; and
(3) by inserting after paragraph $(28)$ , the fol-
lowing new paragraph:
"(29) nursing school clinic services (as defined
in subsection (ee)) furnished by or under the super-
vision of a nurse practitioner or a clinical nurse spe-
cialist (as defined in section $1861(aa)(5)$ ), whether
or not the nurse practitioner or clinical nurse spe-
cialist is under the supervision of, or associated with,
a physician or other health care provider; and".
(b) NURSING SCHOOL CLINIC SERVICES DEFINED.—
Section 1905 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396d)
is amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
section:
"(ee) The term 'nursing school clinic services' means
services provided by a health care facility operated by an
accredited school of nursing which provides primary care,
long-term care, mental health counseling, home health

22 counseling, home health care, or other health care services23 which are within the scope of practice of a registered24 nurse.".

(c) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section
 1902(a)(10)(C)(iv) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
 1396a(a)(10)(C)(iv)) is amended by inserting "and (29)"
 after "(24)".

5 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
6 this section shall be effective with respect to payments
7 made under a State plan under title XIX of the Social
8 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396 et seq.) for calendar quar9 ters commencing with the first calendar quarter beginning
10 after the date of enactment of this Act.

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
