A BILL

To repeal the Federal sugar program.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Free Sugar Act of

- 6 SEC. 2. SUGAR PROGRAM.

SEC. 3.
