- 5 (a) In General.—Section 421(1) of the Congres-
- 6 sional Budget and Impoundment Control Act of 1974 (2
- 7 U.S.C. 658(1)) is amended by striking ", but does not in-
- 8 clude independent regulatory agencies".

- 1 (b) Exemption for Monetary Policy.—The Un-
- 2 funded Mandates Reform Act of 1995 (2 U.S.C. 1501 et
- 3 seq.) is amended by inserting after section 5 the following:
- 4 "SEC. 6. EXEMPTION FOR MONETARY POLICY.
- 5 "Nothing in title II, III, or IV shall apply to rules
- 6 that concern monetary policy proposed or implemented by
- 7 the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System
- 8 or the Federal Open Market Committee.".
