1	SECTION 1. REQUIRING AMOUNTS REMAINING IN SENATE
2	OFFICIAL PERSONNEL AND OFFICE EXPENSE
3	ACCOUNTS TO BE USED FOR DEFICIT REDUC-
4	TION OR TO REDUCE THE FEDERAL DEBT.
5	(a) In General.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
6	sion of law, any amounts appropriated for the Senate Offi-
7	cial Personnel and Office Expense Accounts for the United
8	States Senate for a fiscal year which remain after all pay-
9	ments are made under such accounts for the year shall
10	be deposited in the Treasury and used for deficit reduc-
11	tion, except that in the case of a fiscal year for which there
12	is no Federal budget deficit, such amounts shall be used
13	to reduce the Federal debt (in such manner as the Sec-
14	retary of the Treasury considers appropriate).
15	(b) REGULATIONS.—The Committee on Rules and
16	Administration shall promulgate such regulations as may
17	be necessary to carry out this section.
18	(c) Effective Date.—This section shall apply with
