## A BILL

To require reports by the Comptroller General on Department of Defense military spouse employment programs, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Military Spouse Em-
- 5 ployment Programs Evaluation Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. COMPTROLLER GENERAL REPORTS ON DEPART-
- 7 MENT OF DEFENSE MILITARY SPOUSE EM-
- 8 PLOYMENT PROGRAMS.
- 9 (a) Annual Review Required.—The Comptroller
- 10 General of the United States shall carry out each year a

- 1 review of all current Department of Defense military
- 2 spouse employment programs.
- 3 (b) Elements.—Each review required by subsection
- 4 (a) shall, address, at a minimum, the following:
- 5 (1) The efficacy and effectiveness of Depart-
- 6 ment of Defense military spouse employment pro-
- 7 grams.
- 8 (2) All current Department programs to sup-
- 9 port military spouses or dependents for the purposes
- of employment assistance.
- 11 (3) The types of military spouse employment
- programs that have been considered or used in the
- past by the Department.
- 14 (4) The ways in which military spouse employ-
- ment programs have changed in recent years.
- 16 (5) The benefits or programs that are specifi-
- cally available to provide employment assistance to
- spouses of members of the Armed Forces serving in
- 19 Operation Iraqi Freedom, Operation Enduring Free-
- dom, or Operation New Dawn, or any other contin-
- 21 gency operation being conducted by the Armed
- Forces as of the date of such review.
- 23 (6) Existing mechanisms available to military
- spouses to express their views on the effectiveness
- and future direction of Department programs and

- policies on employment assistance for military
   spouses.
- (7) The oversight provided by the Office of Personnel and Management regarding preferences for
   military spouses in Federal employment.
- 6 (c) COMPTROLLER GENERAL REPORTS.—Not later
  7 than 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act,
  8 and annually thereafter, the Comptroller General shall
  9 submit to the congressional defense committees a report
  10 on the review carried out under subsection (a) during the
  11 year in which such review is carried out. Each report shall

set forth the following:

- 14 (2) In the first report submitted under this sub15 section, such clear and concrete metrics as the
  16 Comptroller General considers appropriate for the
  17 current and future evaluation and assessment of the
  18 efficacy and effectiveness of Department of Defense
  19 military spouse employment programs.
  - (3) A description of the assumptions utilized in the review, and an assessment of the validity and completeness of such assumptions.
- 23 (4) Such recommendations as the Comptroller 24 General considers appropriate for improving Depart-

- 3 (d) Department of Defense Reports.—Not
- 4 later than 180 days after the date of the enactment of
- 5 this Act, and annually thereafter, the Secretary of Defense
- 6 shall submit to the congressional defense committees a re-
- 7 port setting forth the number (or a reasonable estimate
- 8 if a precise number is not available) of military spouses
- 9 who have obtained employment following participation in
- 10 Department of Defense military spouse employment pro-
- 11 grams. The report shall set forth such number (or esti-
- 12 mate) for the Department of Defense military spouse em-
- 13 ployment programs as a whole and for each such military
- 14 spouse employment program.
