## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to provide benefits for children with spina bifida of veterans exposed to herbicides while serving in the Armed Forces during the Vietnam era outside Vietnam, and for other purposes.

- 3 SECTION 1. BENEFITS FOR CHILDREN WITH SPINA BIFIDA
- 4 OF ALL VETERANS EXPOSED TO HERBICIDES

- 6 (a) In General.—Section 1821 of title 38, United
