3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Political Reform and

5 Gridlock Elimination Act".

6 SEC. 2. SENSE OF THE SENATE.

- 7 It is the sense of the Senate that Congress should—
- 8 (1) pass the DISCLOSE Act to prevent a cor-
- 9 porate takeover of our elections and ensure that our

democracy is open, transparent, and controlled by
 the people; and

3 (2) reform Senate rules and procedures to re4 duce excessive obstruction and delay, while pro5 tecting the legitimate rights of individual Senators
