Declaring that a state of war exists between the Government of Libya and the Government and the people of the United States, and making provision to prosecute the same.

- 4 (1) a state of war between the United States
 5 and the Government of Libya is hereby formally de6 clared; and
- 7 (2) the President is hereby authorized and di8 rected—

(A) to employ the entire naval and military 1 2 forces of the United States and the resources of 3 the United States Government to carry on war against the Government of Libya; and 4 5 (B) to issue to private armed vessels of the United States commissions or letters of marque 6 and general reprisal, in such form as the Presi-7 dent shall think proper, and under the seal of 8 the United States, against the vessels, goods, 9 and effects of the Government of Libya. 10
