6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi7 sion of the rules or regulations of the Senate—

8 (1) a Senator, officer of the Senate, or em9 ployee of the Senate may collect from another Sen10 ator, officer of the Senate, or employee of the Senate

within Senate buildings nonmonetary donations of
clothing, toys, food, and housewares for charitable
purposes related to serving persons in need or members of the Armed Services and the families of those
members during the holiday season, if the charitable
purposes do not otherwise violate any rule or regulation of the Senate or of Federal law; and

8 (2) a Senator, officer of the Senate, or em9 ployee of the Senate may work with a nonprofit or10 ganization with respect to the delivery of donations
11 described under paragraph (1).

(b) EXPIRATION.—The authority provided by this
resolution shall expire at the end of the first session of
the 112th Congress.
