CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Prohibiting the President from deploying or maintaining United States Armed Forces in a sustained combat role in Iraq without specific, subsequent statutory authorization.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION REGARDING UNITED STATES**
4 **ARMED FORCES IN IRAQ.**

5 The President shall not deploy or maintain United
6 States Armed Forces in a sustained combat role in Iraq
7 without specific statutory authorization for such use

1 enacted after the date of the adoption of this concurrent
2 resolution.

3 **SEC. 2. RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.**

4 Nothing in this concurrent resolution supersedes the
5 requirements of the War Powers Resolution (50 U.S.C.
6 1541 et seq.).
