JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for the appointment of Michael Lynton as a citizen regent of the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That, in accordance with section 5581 of the Revised Stat-
4 utes of the United States (20 U.S.C. 43), the vacancy on
5 the Board of Regents of the Smithsonian Institution, in
6 the class other than Members of Congress, occurring by
7 reason of the resignation of France A. Córdova of Indiana
8 on March 13, 2014 is filled by the appointment of Michael
9 M. Lynton of California. The appointment is for a term

1 of 6 years, beginning on the date of the enactment of this
2 joint resolution.
