A BILL

To rescind unobligated amounts for foreign assistance to Egypt, and to appropriate funds for the Department of Defense tuition assistance program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RESCISSION; APPROPRIATION FOR TUITION AS-**
4 **SISTANCE.**

5 (a) RESCISSION OF FOREIGN ASSISTANCE TO
6 EGYPT.—

7 (1) IN GENERAL.—Of the aggregate unobli-
8 gated amount available for foreign assistance to
9 Egypt for fiscal year 2013, there is hereby rescinded
10 \$500,000,000.

1 (2) REPORT.—Not later than 60 days after the
2 date of the enactment of this Act, the Director of
3 the Office of Management and Budget shall submit
4 to the committees on appropriations of the House of
5 Representatives and the Senate a report describing
6 the amount and account of each rescission under
7 paragraph (1).

8 (b) APPROPRIATION FOR TUITION ASSISTANCE.—
9 There is appropriated \$500,000,000 for an additional
10 amount to the Department of Defense for fiscal year 2013
11 for tuition assistance under sections 1784a and 2007 of
12 title 10, United States Code.
