To prohibit the further extension or establishment of national monuments in Montana, except by express authorization of Congress, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Montana Land Sov-
5 ereignty Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON NEW NATIONAL MONUMENTS IN**
2 **MONTANA WITHOUT CONGRESSIONAL AP-**
3 **PROVAL.**

4 This proviso of the last sentence of the first section
5 of the Act of September 14, 1950 (64 Stat. 849, chapter
6 950; 16 U.S.C. 431a), is amended by inserting “or Mon-
7 tana” after “Wyoming”.

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
