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## AN ACT

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to study the suitability and feasibility of designating the Prison Ship Martyrs' Monument in Fort Greene Park, in the New York City borough of Brooklyn, as a unit of the National Park System.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

## 1 SECTION 1. PRISON SHIP MARTYRS' MONUMENT STUDY;

2 **REPORT.**3 (a) SHORT TITLE.—This section may be cited as the  
4 “Prison Ship Martyrs’ Monument Preservation Act”.

5 (b) STUDY.—

6 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Inter-  
7 rior shall complete a study to determine the suit-  
8 ability and feasibility of designating the Prison Ship  
9 Martyrs’ Monument in Fort Greene Park, in the  
10 New York City borough of Brooklyn, as a unit of the  
11 National Park System.12 (2) APPLICABLE LAW.—The study required  
13 under this subsection shall be conducted in accord-  
14 ance with section 8(c) of the National Park System  
15 General Authorities Act (16 U.S.C. 1a-5(c)).16 (3) CONTENT OF STUDY.—The study shall in-  
17 clude—18 (A) an analysis of operational issues that  
19 should be considered if the Prison Ship Mar-  
20 tyrs’ Monument were to be designated as a unit  
21 of the National Park System;22 (B) an analysis of the feasibility of admin-  
23 istering the Prison Ships Martyrs’ Monument,  
24 considering its size, configuration, and other  
25 factors, including an annual cost estimate;

(C) an analysis of the economic, educational, and other impacts of the designation of the Prison Ship Martyrs' Monument as a unit of the National Park System;

(D) an analysis of the effect of the designation of the Prison Ship Martyrs' Monument as a unit of the National Park System on—

(i) existing commercial and recreational activities, and on the authorization, construction, operation, maintenance, or improvement of energy production and transmission infrastructure; and

(ii) the authority of State and local governments to manage those activities; and

(E) an identification of any authorities, including condemnation, that will compel or permit the Secretary of the Interior to influence or participate in local land use decisions (such as zoning) or place restrictions on non-Federal lands if the Prison Ship Martyrs' Monument is designated as a unit of the National Park System.

24 (c) NOTIFICATION OF PRIVATE PROPERTY OWN-  
25 ERS.—Upon commencement of the study, owners of pri-

1 vate property in or adjacent to the Prison Ship Martyrs'  
2 Monument shall be notified of the study's commencement  
3 and scope.

4 (d) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the date  
5 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior  
6 shall transmit to the Committee on Natural Resources of  
7 the House of Representatives and the Committee on En-  
8 ergy and Natural Resources of the Senate a report con-  
9 taining the conclusions of the study required by subsection  
10 (b).
