A BILL

To amend the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act to provide for participation in the Exchange of the President, Vice President, and Executive cabinet officials in same manner as Members of Congress and Congressional staff.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “In It All Together
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PARTICIPATION OF PRESIDENT, VICE PRESIDENT,**
2 **AND EXECUTIVE CABINET OFFICIALS IN THE**
3 **EXCHANGE IN SAME MANNER AS MEMBERS**
4 **OF CONGRESS AND CONGRESSIONAL STAFF.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1312(d)(3)(D) of the Pa-
6 tient Protection and Affordable Care Act (42 U.S.C.
7 18032(d)(3)(D)) is amended—

8 (1) in the heading, by inserting “; APPLICATION
9 TO PRESIDENT, VICE PRESIDENT, AND EXECUTIVE
10 CABINET OFFICIALS” after “IN THE EXCHANGE”;
11 and

12 (b) by adding at the end the following new clause:

13 “(iii) APPLICATION TO PRESIDENT,
14 VICE PRESIDENT, AND EXECUTIVE CABI-
15 NET OFFICIALS.—Clause (i) shall apply to
16 the President, Vice President, and an indi-
17 vidual occupying a position listed in section
18 5312 of title 5, United States Code, in the
19 same manner as it applies to a Member of
20 Congress.”.

21 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
22 this section shall take effect as if included in enactment
23 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act.

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
