A BILL

To amend the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 to prohibit the Department of Agriculture from entering into partnerships with foreign governments to promote enrollment in the supplemental nutrition assistance program and to terminate the current Partnership for Nutrition Assistance Initiative between the United States and Mexico.

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Safety Net Abuse Pre-
3 vention (SNAP) Act of 2013”.

4 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL LIMITATION ON USE OF FUNDS AU-**
5 **THORIZED TO BE APPROPRIATED UNDER**
6 **FOOD AND NUTRITION ACT OF 2008.**

7 (a) PROHIBITION ON PROMOTION AGREEMENTS
8 WITH FOREIGN GOVERNMENTS.—Section 18 of the Food
9 and Nutrition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2027) is amended
10 by adding at the end the following:

11 “(g) Funds appropriated pursuant to any authoriza-
12 tion of appropriations in this Act may not be used by the
13 Secretary for any agreement with a foreign government
14 intended to promote enrollment in the program and the
15 availability of program benefits.”.

16 (b) TERMINATION OF EXISTING AGREEMENT.—Ef-
17 fective on the date of the enactment of this Act, the memo-
18 randum of understanding entered into on July 22, 2004,
19 by the Secretary of Agriculture of the United States De-
20 partment of Agriculture and the Secretary of Foreign Af-
21 fairs of the Republic of Mexico and known as the “Part-
22 nership for Nutrition Assistance Initiative” is null and
23 void.

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
