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## A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to provide for timely access to post-mastectomy items under Medicare.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Breast Cancer Recov-  
5 ery Improvement Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. TIMELY ACCESS TO POST-MASTECTOMY ITEMS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1834(h)(1) of the Social  
8 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395m) is amended—

1           (1) by redesignating subparagraph (H) as sub-  
2       paragraph (I); and

3           (2) by inserting after subparagraph (G) the fol-  
4       lowing new subparagraph:

5                       “(H) SPECIAL PAYMENT RULE FOR POST-  
6       MASTECTOMY EXTERNAL BREAST PROSTHESIS  
7       GARMENTS.—Payment for post-mastectomy ex-  
8       ternal breast prosthesis garments shall be made  
9       regardless of whether such items are supplied to  
10      the beneficiary prior to or after the mastectomy  
11      procedure or other breast cancer surgical proce-  
12      dure. The Secretary shall develop policies to en-  
13      sure appropriate beneficiary access and utiliza-  
14      tion safeguards for such items supplied to a  
15      beneficiary prior to the mastectomy or other  
16      breast cancer surgical procedure.”.

17      (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
18      subsection (a) shall take effect as of the date of the enact-  
19      ment of this Act.

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
