2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. HEADSTONES AND MARKERS FOR PLACEMENT**

4 **IN TRIBAL VETERANS' CEMETERIES.**

5 Section 2306 of title 38, United States Code, is
6 amended—

1 (1) in subsection (a)(4), by inserting “or in a
2 veterans’ cemetery on land owned by or held in trust
3 for a tribal organization (as defined in section
4 3765(4) of this title)” after “State”; and

5 (2) in subsection (b)(1), by inserting “a vet-
6 erans’ cemetery on land owned by or held in trust
7 for a tribal organization,” after “a veterans’ ceme-
8 tery owned by a State,”.

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
