A BILL

To prohibit officers and employees of the Internal Revenue Service from initiating any new audits for 180 days.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “HALT the IRS Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. SUSPENSION OF AUTHORITY OF IRS TO INITIATE**
6 **NEW AUDITS.**

7 An officer or employee of the Internal Revenue Serv-
8 ice shall not initiate any new audit of any taxpayer during

1 the 180-day period beginning with the date of the enact-
2 ment of this Act.
