A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to make members of health care sharing ministries eligible to establish health savings accounts.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 **SECTION 1. MEMBERS OF HEALTH CARE SHARING MIN-**
4 **ISTRIES ELIGIBLE TO ESTABLISH HEALTH**
5 **SAVINGS ACCOUNTS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 223 of the Internal Rev-
7 enue Code of 1986 is amended by adding at the end the
8 following new subsection:

1 “(i) APPLICATION TO HEALTH CARE SHARING MIN-
2 ISTRIES.—For purposes of this section, membership in a
3 health care sharing ministry (as defined in section
4 5000A(d)(2)(B)(ii)) shall be treated as coverage under a
5 high deductible health plan.”.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
7 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
8 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
