Mr. BROOKS of Alabama introduced the following bill; which was referred to
the Committee on Foreign Affairs

A BILL

To provide for an accounting of total United States
contributions to the United Nations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPORT ON UNITED STATES CONTRIBUTIONS**
4 **TO THE UNITED NATIONS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the
6 date of the enactment of this Act and annually thereafter,
7 the Director of the Office of Management and Budget
8 shall submit to Congress a report on all assessed and vol-
9 untary contributions, including in-kind, of the United
10 States Government to the United Nations and its affili-

1 ated agencies and related bodies during the previous fiscal
2 year.

3 (b) CONTENT.—The report required under subsection
4 (a) shall include the following elements:

5 (1) The total amount of all assessed and vol-
6 untary contributions, including in-kind, of the
7 United States Government to the United Nations
8 and its affiliated agencies and related bodies during
9 the previous fiscal year.

10 (2) The approximate percentage of United
11 States Government contributions to each United Na-
12 tions affiliated agency or body in such fiscal year
13 when compared with all contributions to each such
14 agency or body from any source in such fiscal year.

15 (3) For each such United States Government
16 contribution—

17 (A) the amount of each such contribution;

18 (B) a description of each such contribution
19 (including whether assessed or voluntary);

20 (C) the department or agency of the
21 United States Government responsible for each
22 such contribution;

23 (D) the purpose of each such contribution;
24 and

(c) SCOPE OF INITIAL REPORT.—The first report required under subsection (a) shall include the information required under this section for the previous three fiscal years.

8 (d) PUBLIC AVAILABILITY OF INFORMATION.—Not
9 later than 14 days after submitting a report required
10 under subsection (a), the Director of the Office of Man-
11 agement and Budget shall post a public version of the re-
12 port on a text-based, searchable, and publicly available
13 Internet Web site.
