3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Information Tech-
5 nology Exchange Program Act of 2013” or the “ITEP
6 Act of 2013”.

7 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF EXCHANGE PROGRAM.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1110(d) of the National
9 Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2010 (5 U.S.C.

1 3702 note) is amended by striking “2013” and inserting
2 “2023”.

3 (b) REPORTING REQUIREMENT.—Section 1110(i) of
4 such Act is amended by striking “2015,” and inserting
5 “2024,”.

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
