A BILL

To require express prior statutory authorization from Congress to carry out any activities under the United States–Afghanistan Strategic Partnership Agreement, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXPRESS PRIOR STATUTORY AUTHORIZATION**
4 **TO CARRY OUT ACTIVITIES UNDER THE**
5 **UNITED STATES–AFGHANISTAN STRATEGIC**
6 **PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT.**

7 The United States Government may not carry out
8 any activities under the United States–Afghanistan Stra-

1 tegic Partnership Agreement, signed on May 2, 2012, and
2 went into effect on July 4, 2012, or any successor agree-
3 ment, for any fiscal year that begins on or after the date
4 of the enactment of this Act absent express prior statutory
5 authorization from Congress to carry out such activities
6 for such fiscal year.
