Mr. BRALEY of Iowa (for himself, Mr. THOMPSON of California, Mr. KING of New York, Mrs. BUSTOS, Mr. DEFazio, Ms. EDWARDS, Mr. CICILLINE, Mr. RAHALL, Mr. LIPINSKI, and Mr. LOBIONDO) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform

A BILL

To require the purchase of domestically made flags of the
United States of America for use by the Federal Government.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “All-American Flag
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT FOR PURCHASE OF DOMESTICALLY**
2 **MADE UNITED STATES FLAGS FOR USE BY**
3 **FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.**

4 Only such flags of the United States of America, re-
5 gardless of size, that are 100 percent manufactured in the
6 United States, from articles, materials, or supplies 100
7 percent of which are grown, produced, or manufactured
8 in the United States, may be acquired for use by the Fed-
9 eral Government.

10 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

11 Section 2 shall apply to purchases of flags made on
12 or after 180 days after the date of the enactment of this
13 Act.

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
