Mr. GRAYSON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Oversight and Government Reform

A BILL

To prohibit the Federal Government from contracting with
an entity that has committed fraud or certain other crimes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON CONTRACTING WITH CON-**
4 **TRACTORS THAT HAVE COMMITTED FRAUD**
5 **OR CERTAIN OTHER CRIMES.**

6 The Federal Government may not enter into a con-
7 tract with an offeror or any of its principals if the offeror
8 certifies that it, or any of its principals—

1 (1) within a three-year period preceding this
2 offer has been convicted of or had a civil judgment
3 rendered against it for—

4 (A) commission of fraud or a criminal of-
5 fense in connection with obtaining, attempting
6 to obtain, or performing a public (Federal,
7 State, or local) contract or subcontract;

8 (B) violation of Federal or State antitrust
9 statutes relating to the submission of offers; or
10 commission of embezzlement, theft, forgery,
11 bribery, falsification or destruction of records,
12 making false statements, tax evasion, violating
13 Federal criminal tax laws; or

14 (C) receiving stolen property;

15 (2) are presently indicted for, or otherwise
16 criminally or civilly charged by a governmental enti-
17 ty with, commission of any of the offenses described
18 in paragraph (1); or

19 (3) within a three-year period preceding this
20 offer, have been notified of any delinquent Federal
21 taxes in an amount that exceeds \$3,000 for which
22 the liability remains unsatisfied.

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
