A BILL

To prepare a feasibility study and implement demonstration projects to restore the San Gabriel River Watershed in California.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “San Gabriel Watershed
5 Restoration Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. SAN GABRIEL RIVER WATERSHED RESTORATION,**
2 **CALIFORNIA.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Chief of the Army Corps of
4 Engineers, in coordination with the County of Los Ange-
5 les, shall—

6 (1) prepare a feasibility study for environmental
7 ecosystem restoration, flood control, water quality
8 control, water supply storage, outdoor recreation en-
9 hancements, and other aspects of the San Gabriel
10 River Watershed revitalization that is consistent
11 with the goals of the San Gabriel River master plan
12 published by the County of Los Angeles; and

13 (2) identify demonstration projects for con-
14 struction and restoration of the San Gabriel River
15 Watershed.

16 (b) DEMONSTRATION PROJECTS.—

17 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Chief of the Army
18 Corps of Engineers is authorized to construct dem-
19 onstration projects in order to provide information
20 to develop the study under subsection (a)(1).

21 (2) FEDERAL SHARE.—The Federal share of
22 the cost of any project under this subsection shall be
23 not more than 65 percent.

1 (3) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

2 There is authorized to be appropriated to carry out

3 this subsection \$50,000,000.

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
