Ms. NORTON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform

A BILL

To amend title 40, United States Code, to require public notice of excess real property, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PUBLIC NOTICE OF EXCESS REAL PROPERTY.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 524 of title 40, United
5 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
6 lowing:

7 “(c) PUBLIC NOTICE OF EXCESS REAL PROPERTY.—

8 “(1) IN GENERAL.—As soon as practicable
9 after receiving a report of excess real property under
10 subsection (a)(3), the Administrator shall provide

1 public notice of the property through publication in
2 the Federal Register.

3 “(2) WAIVERS.—The Administrator may waive
4 the requirement of paragraph (1) if the Adminis-
5 trator determines that the waiver is necessary for
6 reasons of national security.”.

7 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by sub-
8 section (a) shall apply to excess real property reported by
9 an executive agency to the Administrator of General Serv-
10 ices after the date of enactment of this Act.

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
