A BILL

To reauthorize the Multinational Species Conservation Funds Semipostal Stamp, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Multinational Species
3 Conservation Funds Semipostal Stamp Reauthorization
4 Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION.**

6 Section 2(c) of the Multinational Species Conserva-
7 tion Funds Semipostal Stamp Act of 2010 (Public Law
8 111–241; 39 U.S.C. 416 note) is amended—

9 (1) in paragraph (2), by striking “2 years” and
10 inserting “6 years”; and

11 (2) by adding at the end the following:

12 “(5) STAMP DEPICTIONS.—Members of the
13 public shall be offered a choice of 5 stamps under
14 this Act, depicting an African elephant or an Asian
15 elephant, a rhinoceros, a tiger, a marine turtle, and
16 a great ape, respectively.”.

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
