AN ACT

To delay the application of the individual health insurance mandate, to delay the application of the employer health insurance mandate, and for other purposes.

**TITLE I—FAIRNESS FOR
AMERICAN FAMILIES ACT**

SEC. 101. SHORT TITLE.

This title may be cited as the “Fairness for American Families Act”.

**SEC. 102. DELAY IN APPLICATION OF INDIVIDUAL HEALTH
INSURANCE MANDATE.**

(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 5000A(a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking “2013” and inserting “2014”.

(b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

(1) Section 5000A(c)(2)(B) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended—

(A) by striking “2014” in clause (i) and inserting “2015”, and

(B) by striking “2015” in clauses (ii) and (iii) and inserting “2016”.

(2) Section 5000A(c)(3)(B) of such Code is amended—

(A) by striking “2014” and inserting “2015”, and

(B) by striking “2015” (prior to amendment by subparagraph (A)) and inserting “2016”.

1 (3) Section 5000A(c)(3)(D) of such Code is
2 amended—

3 (A) by striking “2016” and inserting
4 “2017”, and

5 (B) by striking “2015” and inserting
6 “2016”.

7 (4) Section 5000A(e)(1)(D) of such Code is
8 amended—

9 (A) by striking “2014” and inserting
10 “2015”, and

11 (B) by striking “2013” and inserting
12 “2014”.

13 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
14 this section shall take effect as if included in section 1501
15 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act.

16 **TITLE II—AUTHORITY FOR** 17 **MANDATE DELAY ACT**

18 **SEC. 201. SHORT TITLE.**

19 This title may be cited as the “Authority for Mandate
20 Delay Act”.

21 **SEC. 202. DELAY IN APPLICATION OF EMPLOYER HEALTH** 22 **INSURANCE MANDATE.**

23 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1513(d) of the Patient
24 Protection and Affordable Care Act is amended by strik-

1 ing “December 31, 2013” and inserting “December 31,
2 2014”.

3 (b) REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.—

4 (1) REPORTING BY EMPLOYERS.—Section
5 1514(d) of the Patient Protection and Affordable
6 Care Act is amended by striking “December 31,
7 2013” and inserting “December 31, 2014”.

8 (2) REPORTING BY INSURANCE PROVIDERS.—
9 Section 1502(e) of the Patient Protection and Af-
10 fordable Care Act is amended by striking “2013”
11 and inserting “2014”.

12 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
13 this section shall take effect as if included in the provision
14 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act to
15 which they relate.
