3 **SECTION 1. ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR THE LAND AND**
4 **WATER CONSERVATION FUND STATE ASSIST-**
5 **ANCE PROGRAM.**

6 Section 5 of the Land and Water Conservation Fund
7 Act of 1965 (16 U.S.C. 460l–7) is amended by inserting

1 “and not less than 40 per centum of such appropriations
2 shall be available for the Land and Water Conservation
3 Fund State Assistance Program” after “Not less than 40
4 per centum of such appropriations shall be available for
5 Federal purposes”.
