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## A BILL

To require the Army Corps of Engineers to notify the public of certain flood predictions regarding the Missouri River System, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Army Corps of Engi-  
5       neers Communications Accountability Act of 2013”.

6       **SEC. 2. NOTIFICATION AND CONSULTATION REQUIRE-**  
7                   **MENTS.**

8       (a) IN GENERAL.—If the Chief of Engineers makes  
9       an upper quartile determination or an upper decile deter-  
10      mination, the Chief of Engineers shall notify the public

1 of such determination, and consult with affected govern-  
2 ments, in accordance with this section.

3 (b) NOTIFICATION.—Not later than 7 days after  
4 making a determination described in subsection (a), the  
5 Chief of Engineers shall notify the public that such deter-  
6 mination has been made.

7 (c) CONSULTATION.—

8 (1) IN GENERAL.—If the Chief of Engineers  
9 makes an upper decile determination, an affected  
10 government may request a consultation with the  
11 Chief of Engineers.

12 (2) DEADLINE.—If an affected government re-  
13 quests a consultation under paragraph (1), the Chief  
14 of Engineers shall provide such consultation not  
15 later than 7 days after receiving the request.

16 (3) CONTENTS.—The Chief of Engineers may  
17 provide in a consultation under this subsection—

18 (A) information regarding expected water  
19 levels;

20 (B) advice regarding appropriate prepared-  
21 ness actions;

22 (C) technical assistance; and

23 (D) any other information or assistance  
24 determined appropriate by the Chief of Engi-  
25 neers.

1           (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

2               (1) AFFECTED GOVERNMENT.—The term “af-  
3               fected government” means a State, local, or tribal  
4               government with jurisdiction over an area that will  
5               be affected by a flood occurring in the Missouri  
6               River System, as determined by the Chief of Engi-  
7               neers in an upper decile determination.

8               (2) ANNUAL OPERATING PLAN.—The term “an-  
9               nual operating plan” means a plan prepared by the  
10              Chief of Engineers that describes potential water  
11              conditions scenarios for the Missouri River System  
12              for a year.

13              (3) UPPER DECILE DETERMINATION.—The  
14              term “upper decile determination” means a deter-  
15              mination that runoff conditions in the Missouri  
16              River System are likely to reach the upper decile  
17              scenario specified for a year in an annual operating  
18              plan.

19              (4) UPPER QUARTILE DETERMINATION.—The  
20              term “upper quartile determination” means a deter-  
21              mination that runoff conditions in the Missouri  
22              River System are likely to reach the upper quartile  
23              scenario specified for a year in an annual operating  
24              plan.
